

**INTERNATIONAL FULBRIGHT
SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY AWARD 2010**

► **Romanian-US Fulbright Commission** is pleased to announce the 2010 International Fulbright Science and Technology Award Program for Ph.D. study at top universities in the fields of science, technology or engineering. Candidates can be **BA** and **MA** students from both **public** and **private universities** in Romania.

The grantees will receive tuition, a monthly stipend for up to 36 months, health and accident coverage, a book and equipment allowance, professional conference allowance, travel support, and specially tailored enrichment activities, and are eligible to apply for additional research funding. After three years, US universities have agreed to fund the remaining expenses toward completion of a PhD.

► **Eligible fields:** Aeronautics and Astronomics/Aeronautical Engineering, Agriculture (Theoretical or Research-Based Focus only), Astronomy/Planetary Sciences, Biology, Biomedical Engineering, Chemistry, Computer Sciences/Engineering, Energy, Engineering (Electrical, Chemical, Civil, Mechanical, Ocean, and Petroleum), Environmental Science/Engineering, Geology/Earth And Atmospheric Sciences, Information Sciences and Systems (Engineering Focus only), Materials Science/Engineering, Mathematics, Neuroscience/Brain and Cognitive Sciences, Oceanography, Public Health (Theoretical Research Focus only) and Physics.

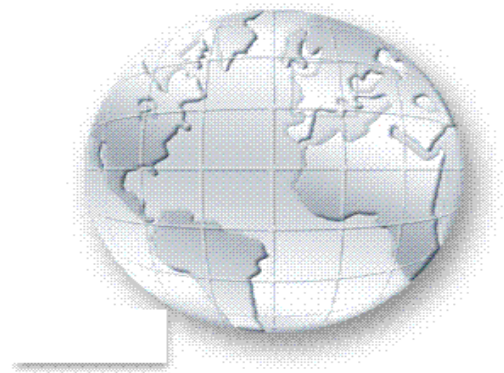
► **Grant duration:** 3 years (starting August 2010)

► **Applicants must meet the following selection criteria:**

- hold a university degree before August 1st, 2010;
- have fluency in English;
- have Romanian citizenship.

► **Each candidate will be required to submit:**

- an online application (<https://apply.embark.com/student/fulbright/international>)
- three letters of reference (submitted electronically and attached to the online application or official paper copies sent by mail);
- official academic transcripts from each post-secondary institution attended (or scanned and attached to the online application);
- score reports (as soon as available, but prior to August 17th, 2009).



Application deadline: April 29th, 2009

► **Only online applications will be accepted.** Additional documentation such as transcripts and letters of recommendation can be sent online or by usual mail (postmarked April 29th) to the Romanian-U.S. Fulbright Commission, st. Nicolae Costinescu, nr. 2, cod 011878, sector 1, București.

► **Note:** Test vouchers for exam registration will be provided to the Romanian final nominees who must take TOEFL and GRE.
